

How does the Viewtracker macro affect the performance of the Confluence page?

The viewtracker macro up to Version 3.2.2 affects the performance of the page if it has a large number of unique (registered) visitors (mainly in large Confluence installations). However, if you experience performance problems, just disable the rendering of the links to the user profile pages:

```
{viewtracker:renderusernames=false}
```

In Version 4.0 we rewrote a large part of the add-on so that the performance is much better, especially on large instances.
