

# How to track just a single page or specific pages?

## Disable Autotracking

Per default every view is tracked since version 5.1.0. If you would like to disable this behaviour - just go to [Administration](#) and deactivate the "Desktop" option.

**Please note:**  
Tracking of mobile views is managed with the options below "Desktop"

#### Tracking

Desktop

If enabled: all pages and blog posts will be monitored and user browsing will be tracked. If disabled: only pages and blog posts with the Viewtracker macro will be monitored and tracked.

Below Version 5.4.0 the settings have a different look.

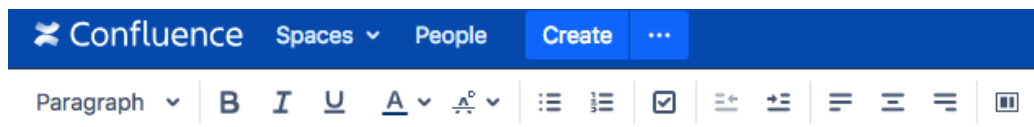
Auto track views

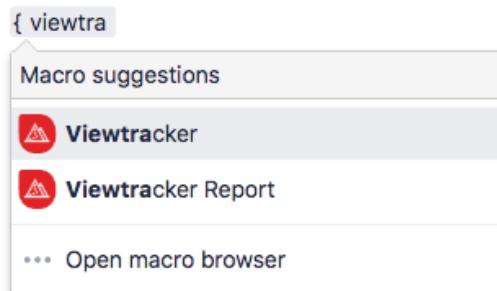
## Tracking of single pages
